A triple bill with Tim Moss

The DiviCiti project, funded by the DFG between 2020 and 2023, studied how political division has influenced energy infrastructures and shaped energy strategies across the recent histories of Berlin, Jerusalem and Nicosia and what their experiences reveal about conflict and cooperation over urban energy in contested contexts.

In an event marking the end of the project, Tim will first present the main findings for discussion. He will then talk through the project proposal as an example of a successful DFG bid and give advice that might help with your own proposals. To round it off, he will reflect on what happened between the proposal and the findings, covering the adaptations demanded by the realities of research we usually conceal from our papers and conference presentations.
