Guidelines for the application for THESys Pre-Doc Scholarships 2022

Who can apply?

You can only apply if you are an outstanding Master student as well as graduate and plan to pursue your doctorate at IRI THESys, Humboldt-Universität. The following conditions have to be fulfilled:

- 1. Academic excellence, usually proven by an outstanding university degree (at least Bachelor),
- 2. An original, high-quality draft of the doctoral project relating to the IRI THESys fields of research,
- 3. Pre-existing skills or exceptional motivation, which bode well for successful completion of doctoral studies, and
- 4. Very good knowledge of English.

Though, a finished MA is not a pre-condition, candidates need to be in the final stage of their MA studies. Candidates who are receiving a stipend are not eligible. Candidates who are already enrolled as doctoral students are also not eligible.

What is the duration of the scholarships?

These short-term scholarships will be granted in 2022 for up to four months. The earliest starting date is expected to be 1st September 2022. Scholarships cannot be granted beyond December 2022.

What is the amount of the scholarship?

The scholarship amounts to 1,468 € per month (including 103 EUR research allowance) plus 400 € children supplement for the first child and 100 € for siblings ("Kinderzuschlag").

Application procedure

Which documents need to be included in the application?

- A motivation letter (max. 1 page), addressed to the Graduate Program Board
- Curriculum vitae (max. 2 pages) incl. title and supervisor of your Bachelor thesis and Master thesis,

- Draft that sketches your research project (max. 3.000 characters),
- Certificates of your academic degrees (at least Bachelor) and/or, if applicable, transcripts (of grades) for courses attended,
- A proposal for a prospective THESys supervisor who fits your research topic (for detailed information on our THESys supervisors, please visit our website: <u>https://www.iri-thesys.org/people/thesys-members/</u>).

Where do I need to hand in my application documents?

The application documents need to be handed in electronically. The documents need to be saved in **one** PDF document.

We will confirm the reception of your application documents.

The application deadline is 15th August 2022.

Selection Procedure

All applications are checked for completeness and correctness by the program coordinator.

(1) A selection committee of the IRI THESys decides on the awarding of the scholarships on the basis of the submitted documents.

(2) The selection committee is composed of the members of the THESys Program Board, but without the PhD representatives.

(3) The award criteria that will be considered in the selection procedure are:

- Academic excellence, usually proven by an outstanding university degree (at least Bachelor),
- Originality and quality of the draft of the doctoral project,
- Compatibility between the suggested research project and the proposed THESys supervisor,
- Pre-existing skills or exceptional motivation.

Based on the application submitted, the selection committee decides at its own discretion to whom scholarships should be awarded.

Upon acceptance of the scholarship, the scholarship holder is obligated to immediately report any changes (e.g. new funding sources) that are relevant to the granting of the scholarship.
